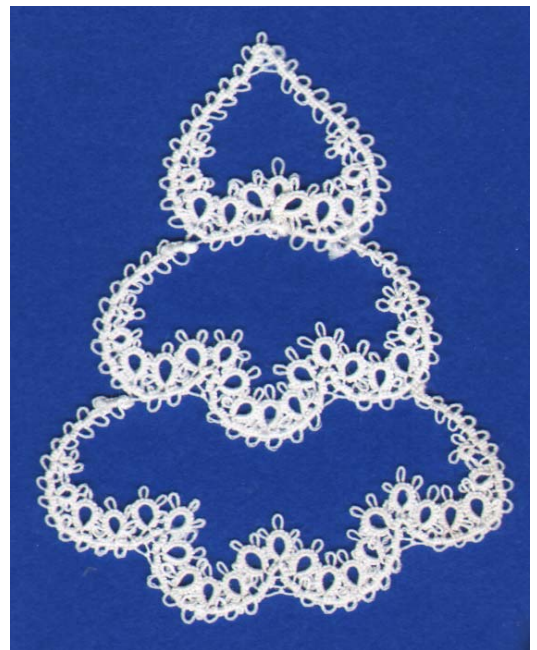

RW=reverse work

sample made with Coron Cotton size 160
measures 5.3cm tall by 4.3cm wide
(2 inches by 1.75 inches)

Row#1: Top Layer

load shuttle with thread and color of your choice. The pearl tatted chain consists of 3 double stitches on either side of the core thread. In the diagram, shuttle #1 is depicted as blue and red for shuttle #2.

Trefoil at inside point:

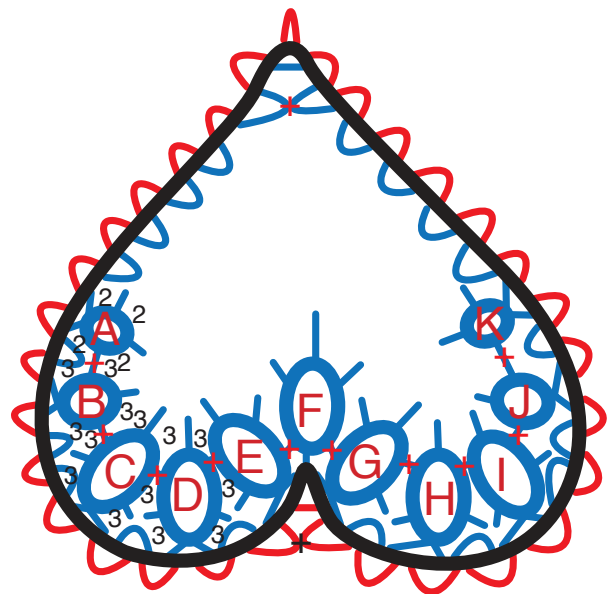
[sh#1] RE: 3-3+(to last p of RD)3-3-3-3, CLR
[sh#1] 3
[sh#1] RF: 3+(to last p of RE)3-3-3-3-3, CLR
[sh#1] 3
[sh#1] RG: 3+(to last p of RF)3-3-3-3-3, CLR
[sh#2] Pull thread in as tight as you can to make a sharp corner. Make 3 ds.
PLJ to adjacent picot.
[sh#1] 3

Continue in reverse order for other side of arc up to ring K. Make a length of pearl chain with 5 picots for each side.

[sh#1] 3
[sh#2] 3-3
[sh#1] Pull thread in as tight as you can to make a sharp corner. Make 3ds.
PLJ to adjacent picot.

Continue for another length of pearl chain with 4 picots for each side.
Tie and work in ends.

Top Layer



Row#2: Middle Layer

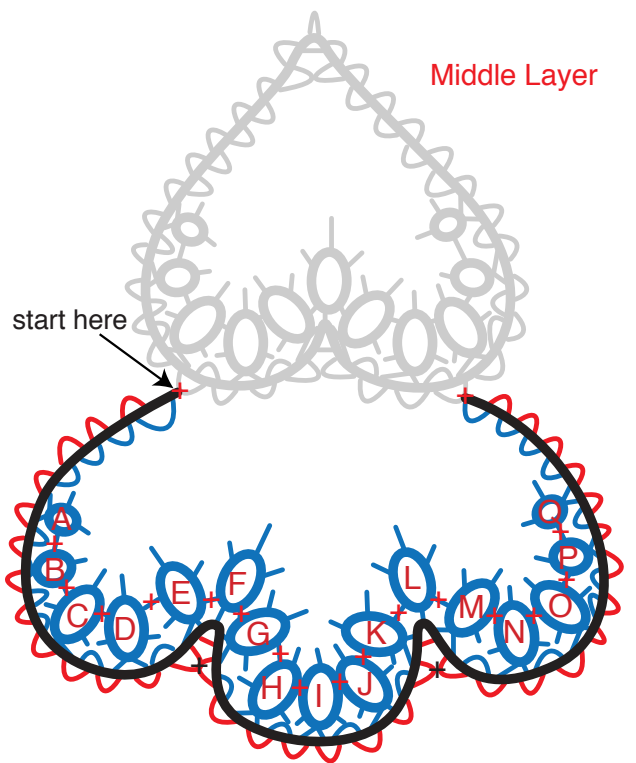
Tie threads to lower picot of pearl chain after ring C of top layer.
Start with shuttle #2 to begin the pearl chain.

[sh#2] 3

[sh#1] 3

Continue with pearl chain for a total of 4 picots on each side of core thread up to ring A. Follow the instructions from Row #1 from rings A to I. This is the halfway point. Reverse the order of instructions for the other half. Finish with a pearl chain of 4 picots on each side after making ring Q. Join threads to lower picot of pearl chain after ring H of top layer.

Tie and work in ends.



Row#3: Bottom Layer

Tie threads to lower picot of pearl chain after ring C of top layer.
This layer is just like the middle layer, but add one more scallop.
Start with shuttle #2 to begin the pearl chain.

[sh#2] 3

[sh#1] 3

Continue with pearl chain for a total of 4 picots on each side of core thread up to ring A. Follow the instructions from Row #2 from rings A to L. This is the halfway point. Reverse the order of instructions for the other half. Finish with a pearl chain of 4 picots on each side after making ring W. Join threads to lower picot of pearl chain after ring N of middle layer.

Tie and work in ends.
