This pattern features picots that are crossing and passing through and rings thrown off the bottom half of a split ring. Sample made from DMC perle coton size 8.

Abbreviations:

R=ring
CH=chain
"-="picot
"-_"=very long picot
"+="join
RW=reverse work
CLR=close ring
SR=split ring

 =chain
 =picot
 =join
 =split ring

Row#1

Load 2 shuttles using CTM

SRA: 6--6/3[RB: 3-2-2-3, CLR]2[RC: 5+(to last p of RB)3-3-5, CLR]2[RD: 5+(to last p of RC)3-3-5, CLR]2[RE: 3+(to last p of RD)2-2-3, CLR]3, CLR

CH: 3, RW

RF: 3--5--3-3--5--3, CLR, RW

CH: 3

SRG: 6--6/3[RH: 3+(to last p of RE)2-2-3, CLR].....

Continue finishing SRG and R's I, J, and K.

CH: 3, RW

RL: 3+(pass long p of RG first through last p of RF and then through 4th p of RF, join to 4th p of RF and leave remaining p of RF loose for now)5+(to long picot of RF)3-3--5--3, CLR.

This completes one set. Continue for desired length.
