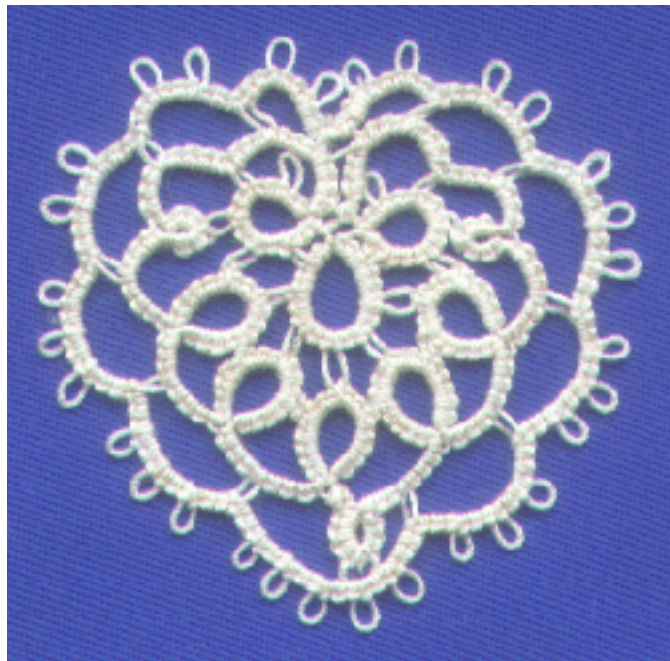


Heart Pattern

Abbreviations:

r=ring
cl=close
LR=large ring
sr=small ring
ch=chain
rw=reverse work
"- "=picot
"+ "=joining to
"-- "=large picot



Requires one shuttle and a ball. I used size 70 ecru thread.

Row #1

Starting at the cloverleaf in the center:

*r, 3-3-3-3-3-3, cl r

LR, 3+(join to last picot of prev. ring)3-3-3-3-3-3, cl r

r, 3+(join to last picot of prev. ring)3-3-3-3-3, cl r, rw

ch, 4-4-4, join to 2nd picot of first ring of cloverleaf,

ch, 4-4, rw

sr, 3+(join to next picot of same ring)3, cl r, rw

ch, 4-4, rw

r, 6+(join to next picot of same ring)3+(join to next free
picot of next ring of cloverleaf)3-6, cl r, rw

ch, 4-4, rw

r, 6+(join to last picot of prev. ring)3+(join to next picot
of same ring of cloverleaf)3-6, cl r, rw

ch, 4-4, rw

r, 6+(join to last picot of prev. ring)3+(join to next picot
of same ring of cloverleaf)3-6, cl r, rw

sr, 4-4, rw *

Repeat from *-* for other half of heart. Tie and cut.

Row #2

Tie ball and shuttle threads to joining of first and last
picots of first and last chains of row #1.

*ch, 3-3-3, join to next free picot of first chain in row #1

ch, 3-3-3, join to next free picot of next chain in row #1

ch, 3-3-3-3, join to next free picot of next chain in row #1

Repeat two more times.

ch, 3-3-3-3-3-3, join to next free picot of next chain in row #1*

Repeat from *-* for other half of 2nd row.

Tie and cut.
